Dear Members,

As this year draws to a close, I would like to take the time to reflect on the past year and my time spent as

President of the LVMA. I have had the privilege of serving with a wonderful group of veterinarians from across the state of Louisiana, encompassing varying backgrounds and practices. Their different perspectives, experiences and insights have been such a blessing and inspiration for me to continue to learn and better myself both professionally and personally. Representing Louisiana I have met veterinarians across the region at several meetings and conferences through the year. Recently I was able to join the Pet Overpopulation Advisory Council at their last meeting at the State Capitol as they awarded grants to several groups throughout the state working tirelessly to provide spay/neuter services to underserved members of the community. It was really an amazing experience. The Council could really benefit from more support from the veterinary community, and I urge you to see if there are any ways you can help in your area.

I encourage each of you to become more involved in

your local VMAs to meet with veterinarians and form connections outside your own workplaces. These are great ways to meet colleagues in your area, discuss common issues you may be facing, and problem solve together. You can also make connections with veterinarians outside your scope of practice that you may need to reach out to – I have had the pleasure of meeting multiple zoo medicine vets from Audubon that have been very helpful when the occasional exotic “stray” makes its way into the shelter. And its never a bad idea to have an equine vet on speed dial just in case you happen to acquire a horse or two.

Organizations also keep you informed and up to date of the latest issues affecting our profession in our state and across the country. A recent ballot initiative passed in Colorado allowing for the creation of a mid-level practitioner. This new role, which some compared to that of a nurse practitioner or physician assistant in human medicine, would have a scope of practice that includes duties and tasks typically limited to veterinarians such as diagnosing conditions, providing prognoses and performing neutering through spaying/castration on cats & dogs. Currently there is no national or state exam for the position.

Louisiana veterinarians have been very

fortunate with the strong support we receive at the state level. Our wonderful lobbying team along with the Legislative Committee tirelessly monitor any legislation that may affect our profession. With Board Members sitting on the AVMA House of Delegates as well as members of LSU faculty, we are always staying on top of potential issues affecting our region.

I have enjoyed my time serving you and look forward to seeing you at this year's Winter Meeting. It is in Baton Rouge, February 21-23, and registration is open online. Before then I wish all of you a Merry Christmas and very Happy Holiday Season!
